At the end of recruitment in your country, we will send you a summary of your country's responses. If all SLPs working in tracheostomy in your country complete this survey, you will have a powerful document to support local improvements.

Tracheostomies are commonly used in children and adults in different settings, including intensive care, rehabilitation units and community. These are complex patients who require a multi-professional approach to management with SLPs playing a key role. Despite their common use, tracheostomy tube type, weaning, oral feeding and vocalisation practices vary widely across location and between professionals. International research providing a clear 'one-size fits all' package of care is not available.
